METHODOLOGY	<p><b>Time:</b> 3 hours (1 hour to prepare it in class, 2 hours to present the project orally)</p> <p><b>Methodology:</b></p> <p>Students do an activity related to a typical festivity in their country and they explain it to their partners. They can do it as they want. But the most important thing is to be as creative as they can. This activity is just oral!!! They can prepare activities to do with the other students, they can prepare a blog, different photos, etc. They will be in pairs, they will have about 10 minutes to explain and they must be very successful. Their partners will assess them. We, as teachers, can make a RUBRICS so that they know what will be assess, we can give it to them before preparing the oral presentation.</p>
