I looked it up in my dictionary

4. Verbs amb dues parts que no es poden separar.

Who looks after your dog when you are away?

L'objecte (your dog) no es pot posar entre el verb (looks) i la partícula (after).

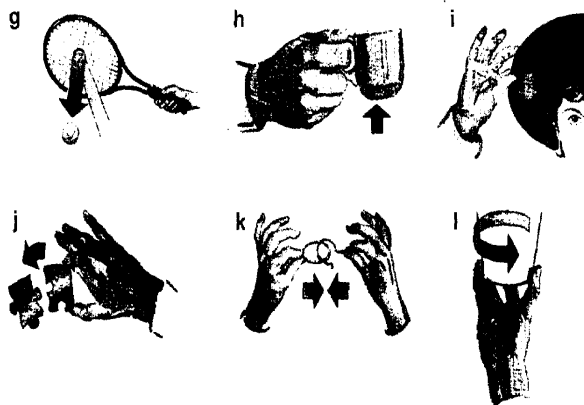
