Santa Claus is coming to town.

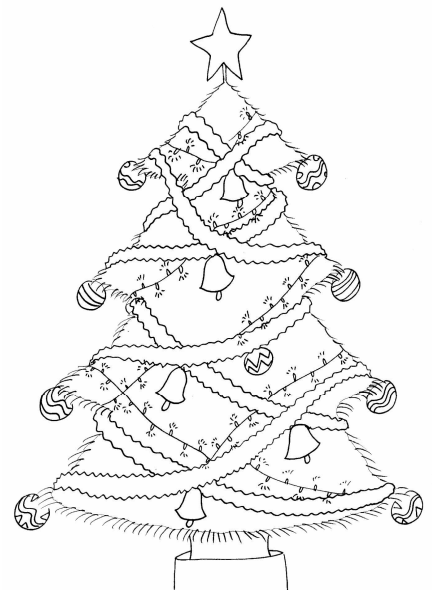

Frosty the Snowman

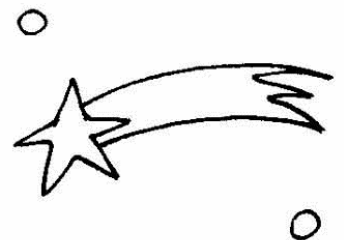
Frosty the snowman

Without any fear

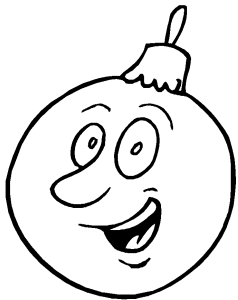
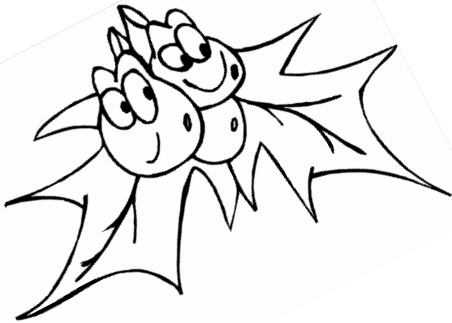

mommy kissing Santa Claus last night.

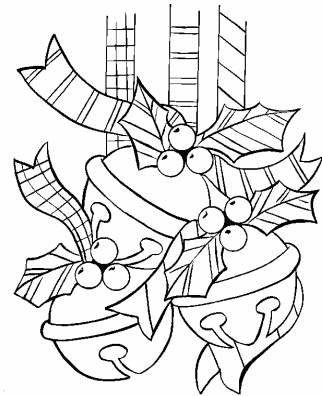

And off to sleep we go.

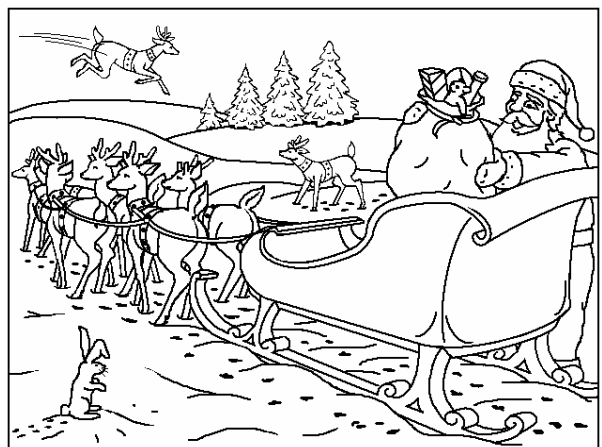

I WANT A HIPPOPOTAMUS FOR CHRISTMAS

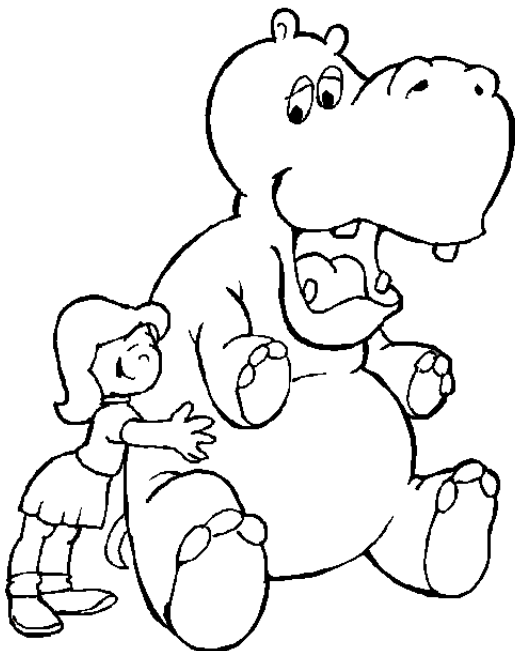
I want a hippopotamus for Christmas

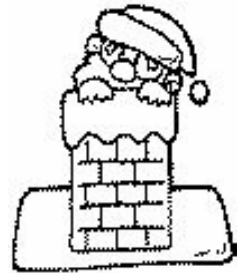

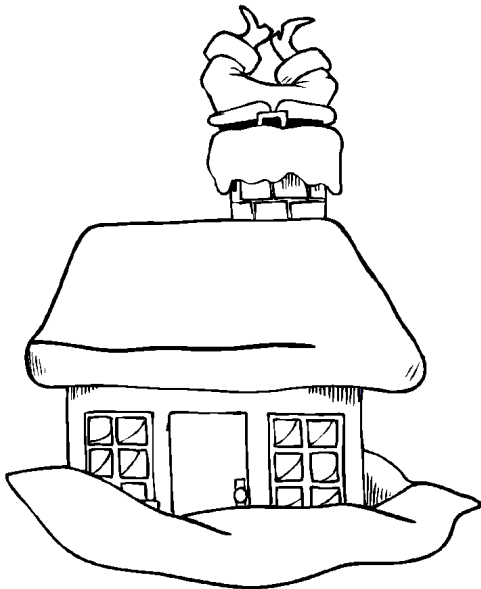
