

SERVEI EDUCATIU DE ZONA

El Servei Educatiu del Pla d'Urgell is a multi-professional team which provides support and advice to public and state-subsidized schools (concertades) from non-university educational levels.

Within el Servei Educatiu del Pla d'Urgell there are el Centre de Recursos Pedagògics (CRP, educational resources center), l'Equip d'Assessorament Psicopedagògic (EAP, educational psychology support and guidance team) and l'Equip de Suport i Assessorament en Llengua, Interculturalitat i Cohesió social (ELIC, linguistic, intercultural and social cohesion team), operating in the schools in a specific way. In addition, qualified professionals work at el Centre de Recursos Educatius per a Discapacitats Audítiu i alumnes amb trastorns greus del llenguatge (CREDA, Educational Resource Center for the hearing impaired and students with severe language disorders) and el Centre de Recursos Educatius per a Discapacitats Visuals (CREDV, resource center for the visually impaired).

Educational service responsibilities include giving advice and guidance to teachers, students and families; supporting and giving advice on school projects; collaborating and promoting dynamic educational activities; managing the continuing Ed teachers training; and giving information and advice on teaching materials, curriculum and other educational resources.

EAP EQUIP D'ASSESSORAMENT PSICOPEDAGÒGIC

EAP is a multidisciplinary service which provides educational psychology to schools to help provide the most appropriate educational response, especially to students with disabilities and those who have difficulties in the learning process. The functions are:

- Identify and assess the special educational needs of students, in collaboration with the school.
- Participate in the training and monitoring of different types of curriculum adaptations students may need.
- Advise teaching staff in terms of psycho-educational aspects and attention to diversity.
- Advise students, families and teams of teachers on aspects of personal and educational orientation.
- Collaborate with social and health local services, so as to provide coordinated care to students and needy families.
- Provide support and educational psychology technical criteria to other organizations in Educational Administration.

CRP CENTRE DE RECURSOS PEDAGÒGICS

Supports educational activities of schools and training teachers by:

- Offering resources, infrastructure and services to schools and teachers, as well as having specific material of different areas and technologies.
- Cataloguing of the local and regional resources, in collaboration with several institutions (*Estany d'Ivars i Vila-sana, Espai Cultural dels Canals d'Urgell, Museu de Vestits de Paper, Biblioteca Comarcal Jaume Vila, Arxiu Comarcal, Institut d'Estudis Comarcals, ...*) and development of guidelines and additional information to facilitate teachers use.
- Giving support to educational activities and exchange of educational experiences, to promote teacher reflection on teaching practice, by organizing annual meetings to exchange experiences, workshops, conferences and online networking.
- Coordinating and organizing of the implementation and monitoring of the continuing Ed for teachers, planning the detection of training needs and developing proposals to meet them.
- Organizing and supporting of educational activities for students of the region.
- Giving support and advice to the development of various projects: autonomy, eduCAT1x1, coexistence, puntedu...

ELIC EQUIP DE LLENGUA INTERCULTURALITAT I COHESIÓ SOCIAL

Provides support and gives advice to schools and teachers in relation to linguistic and intercultural aspects and social cohesion. The functions are:

- Give advice on organizing *l'aula d'acollida* (newcomers program) and attention on students exposed to risk of social exclusion.
- Collaborate in awareness-raising, promotion and consolidation of the Catalan language, and introduction of intercultural education in the educational process.
- Offer guidance on school documents adequacy.
- Give advice on tutorial support either for new students or students exposed to risk of social exclusion.

CREDA / CREDV

CREDA reinforces teaching into those students with severe hearing difficulties and/or language. CREDV performs the same function for students with visual impairments. In addition, both programs provide care and guidance to those students and their families.
