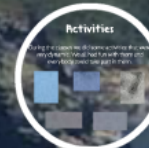


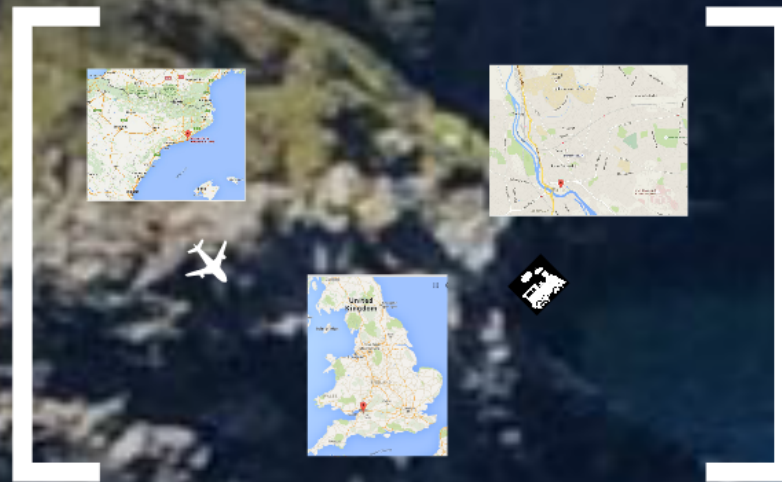

got a train to Exeter.



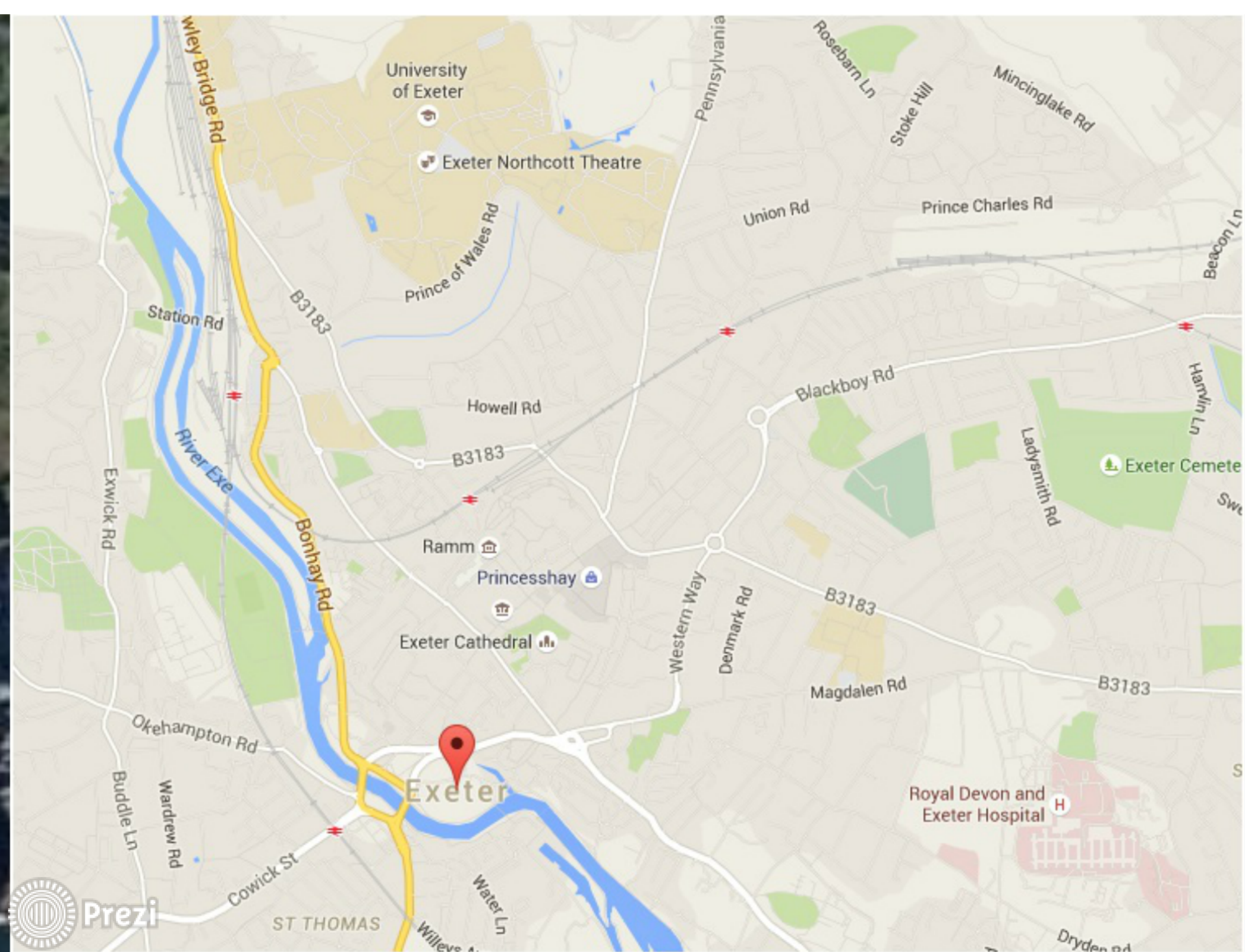

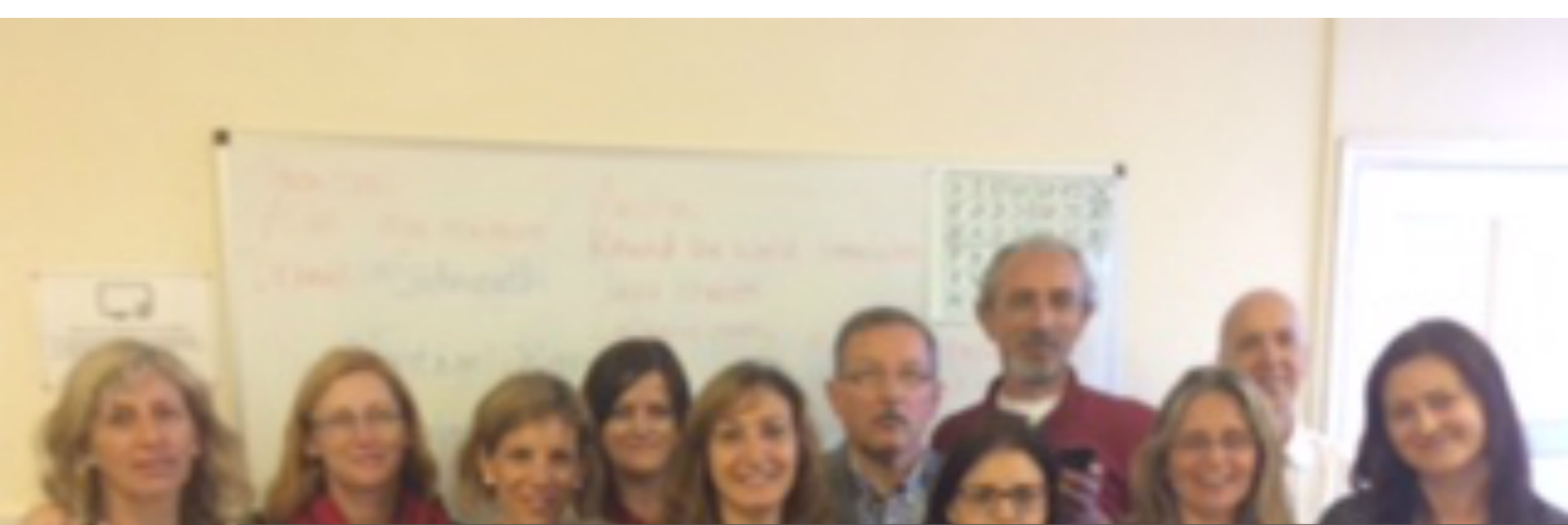


At school

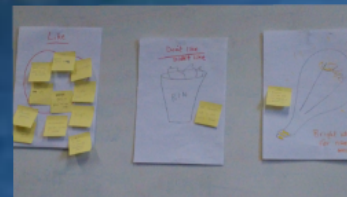
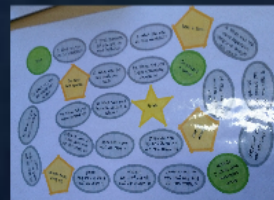
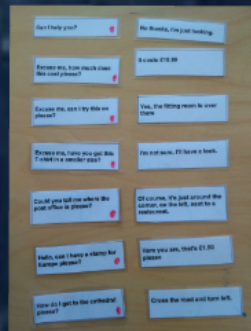

Kay was amazed at what his brother had done.




Everyone soon knew that Arthur had pulled the sword from the stone.



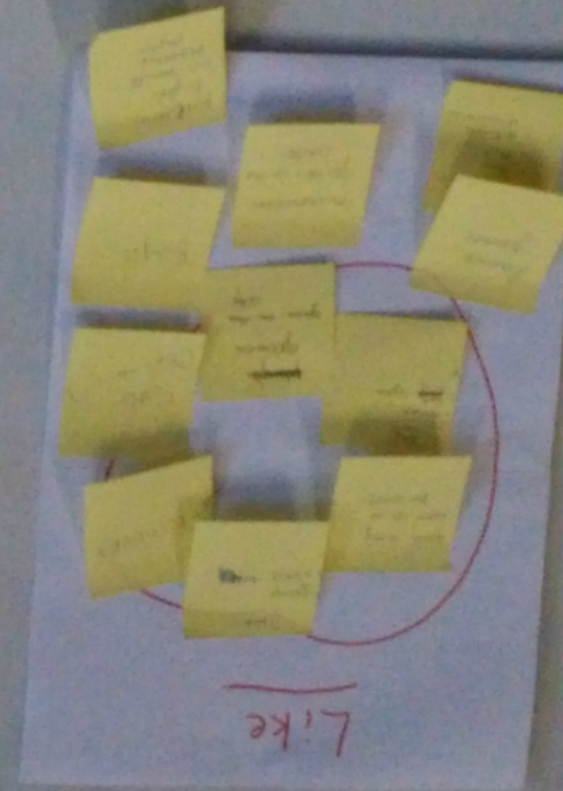
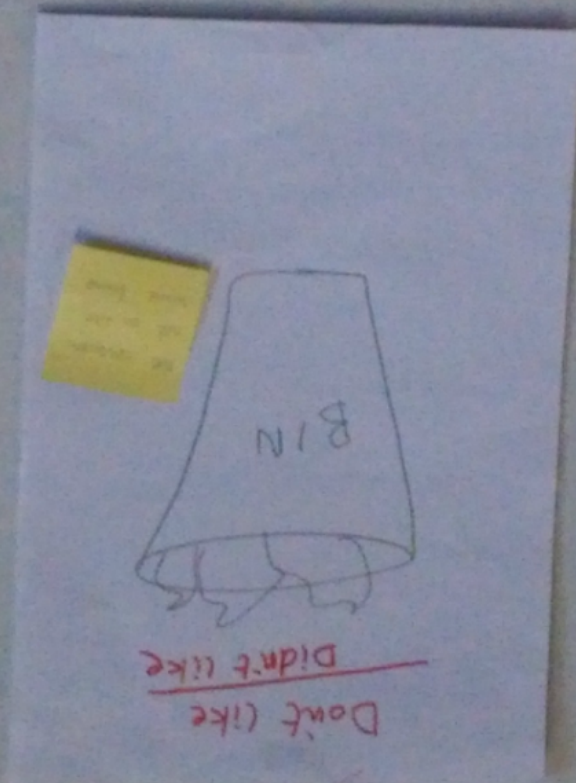
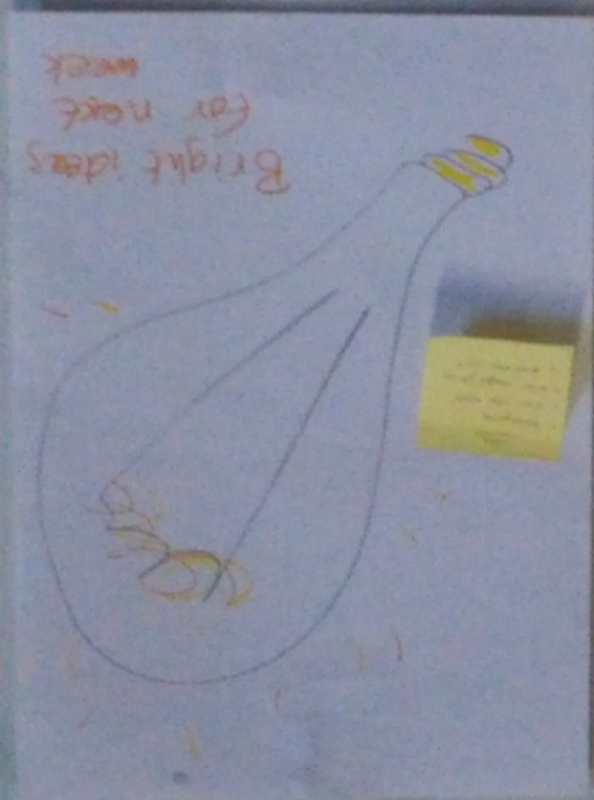
Merlin explained that Arthur was Uther's son and was the true born King of all Britain.

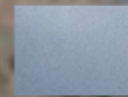
