- Decide if it is a man or a woman.

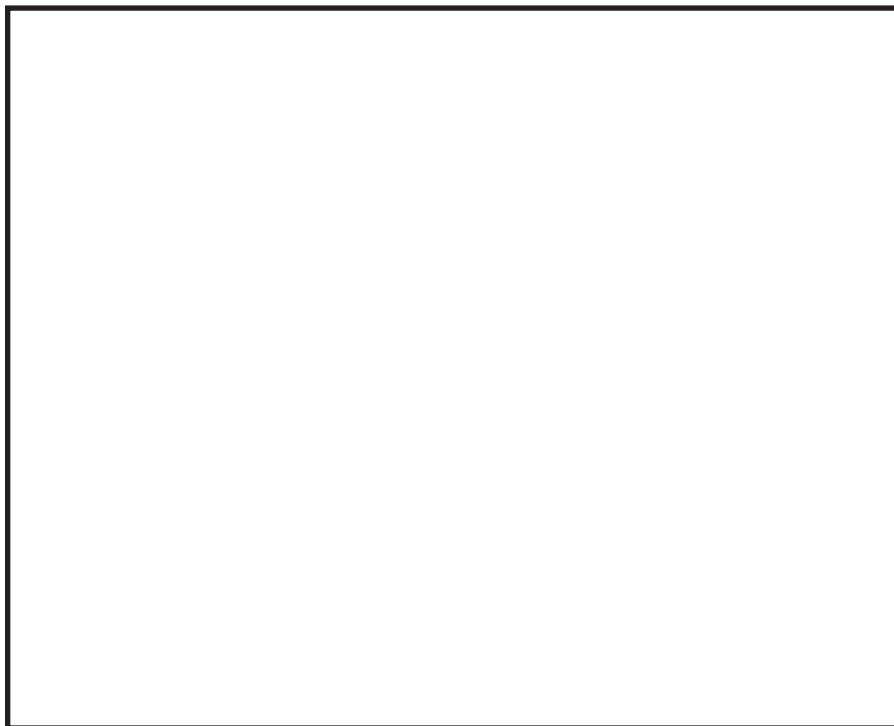

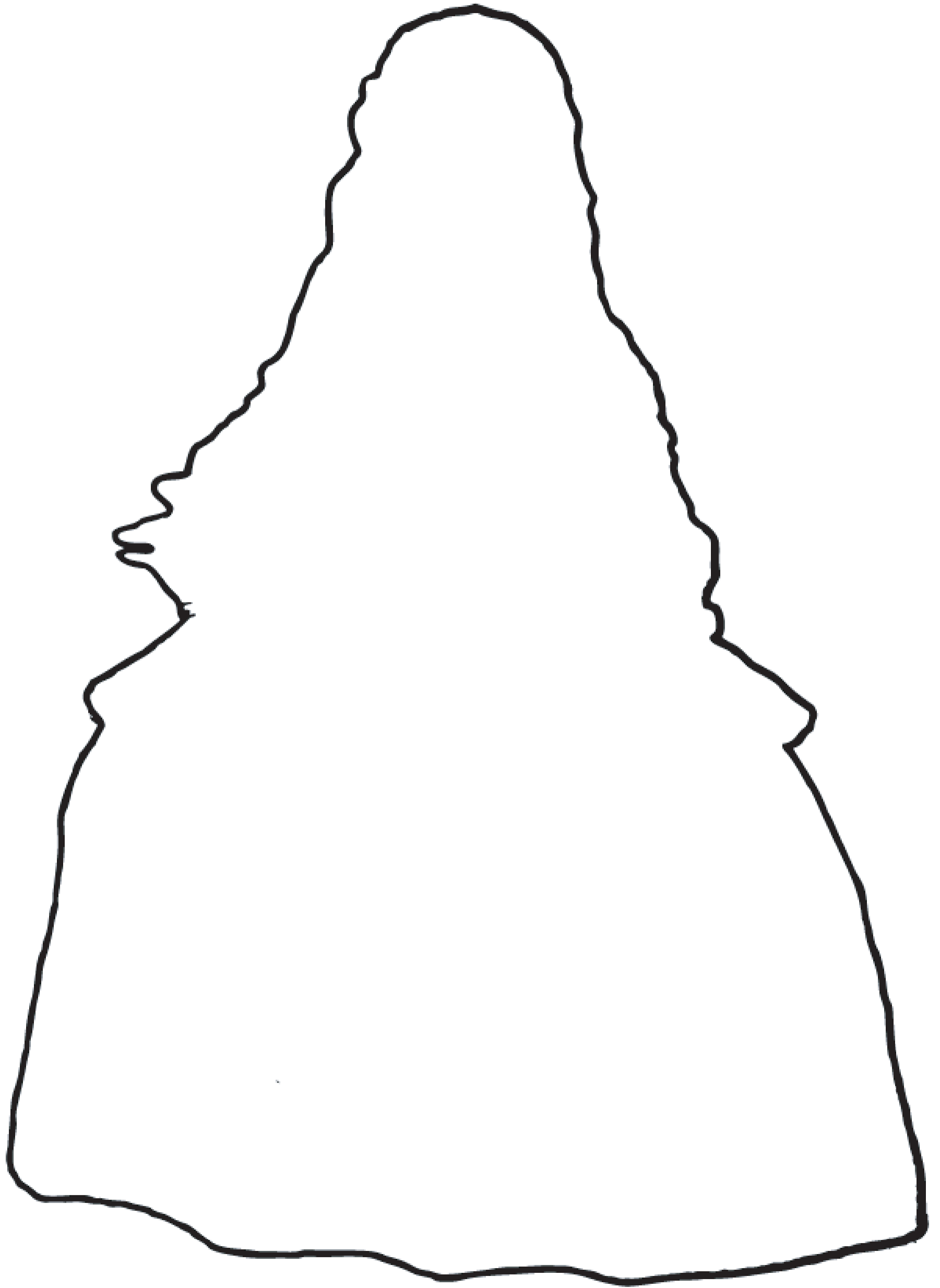

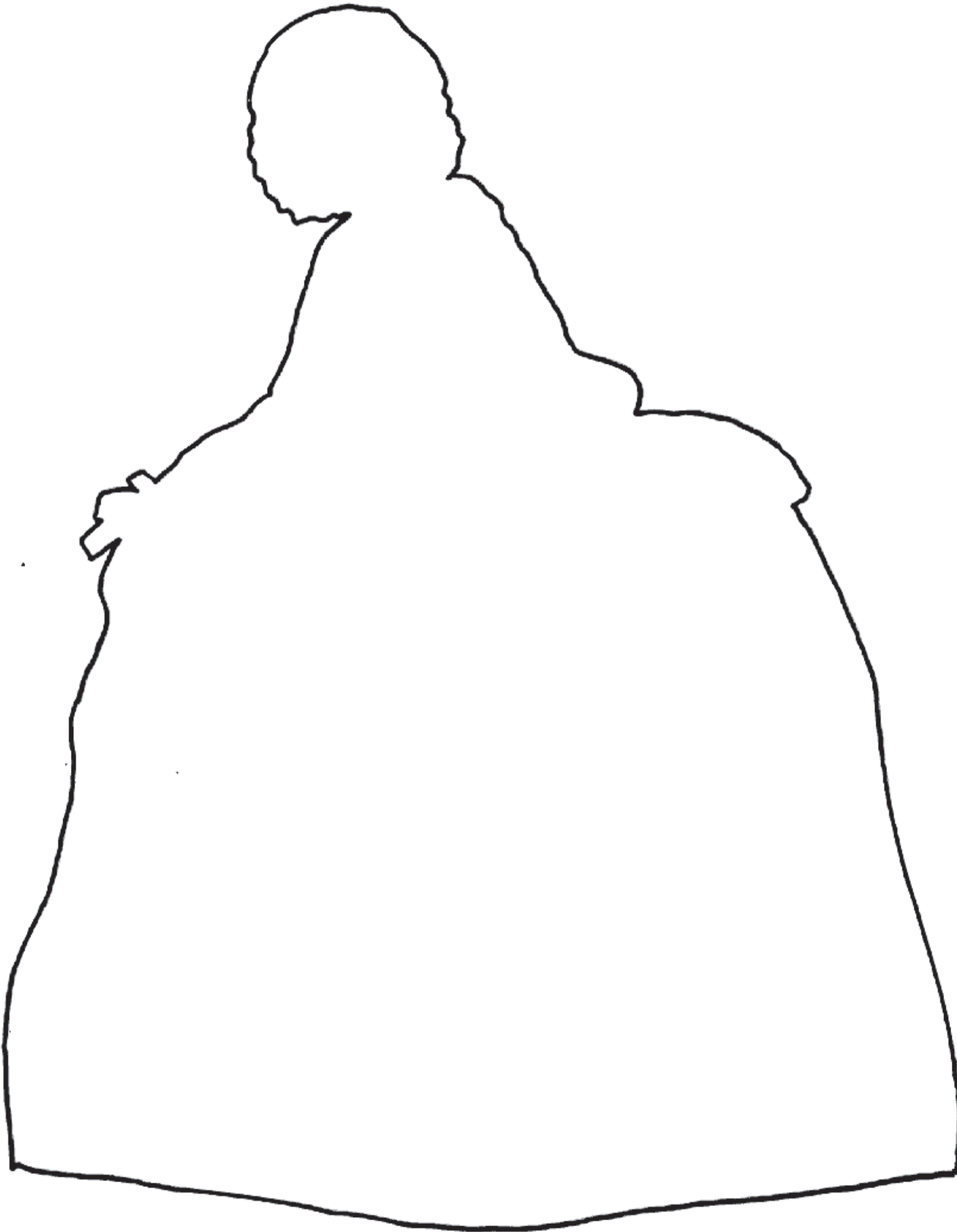
*Instructions for my partner's dictation:*

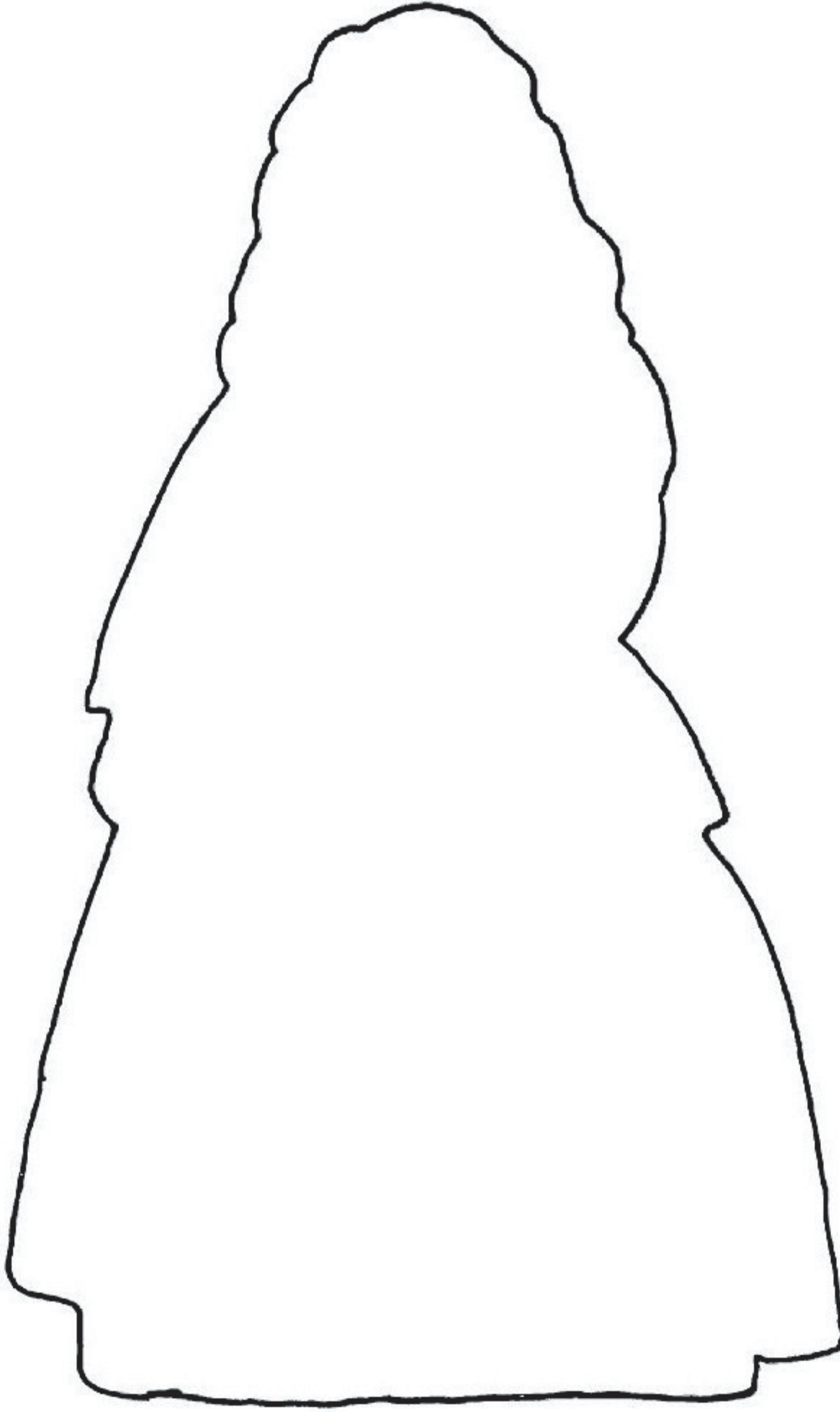

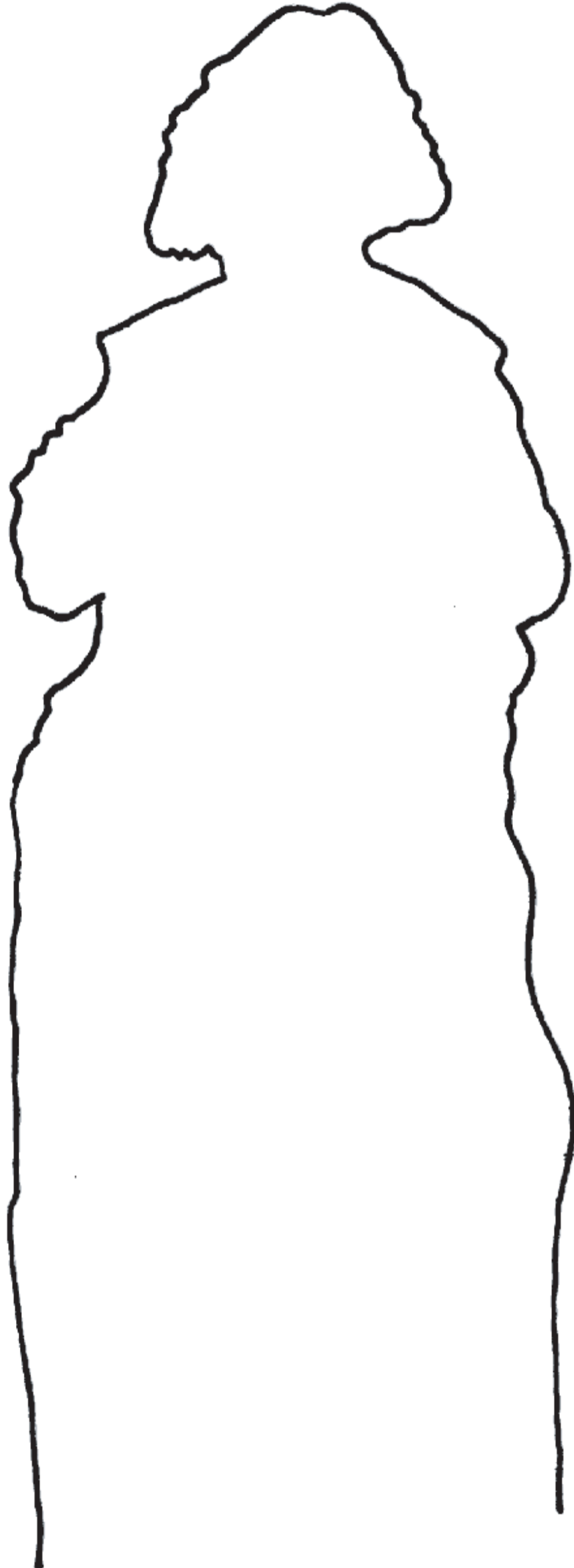
