- 1- FLAG, The flag of Catalonia or *Senyera*, has four red stripes on a golden background.
- 2- NATIONAL DAY, It is on 11 September, and it is called *La Diada*.
- *3* NATIONAL ANTHEM, The national anthem of Catalonia is *Els Segadors*.
- 4- FESTIVAL, *La Diada de Sant Jordi* is celebrated in all the towns of Catalonia on 23 April.

The *sardana* is the most characteristic Catalan popular dance, other groups also practice *Ball de bastons* and *Havaneres*



- 4- THE OWL, it was considered a protector of the Greek armies.




The Misirlou, is a well known and popular Greek dance.
