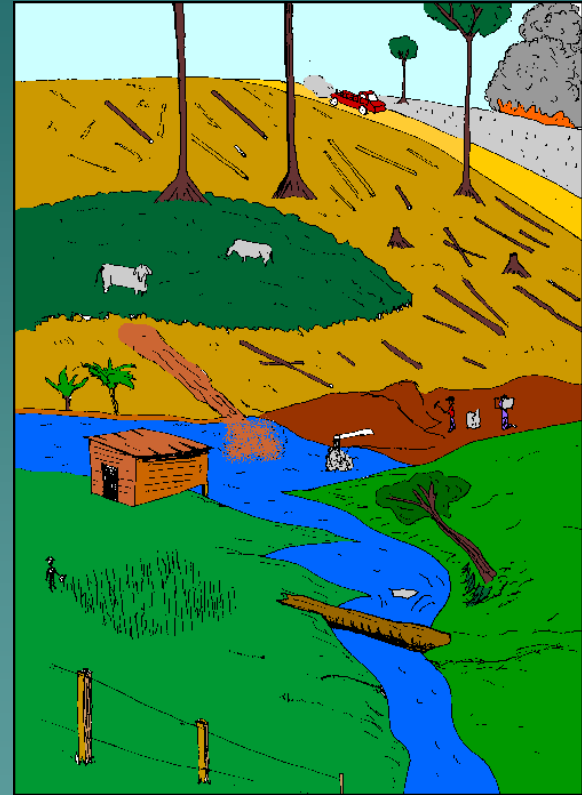
Why are habitats in danger?
