Countable and uncountable nouns

- a I like *crisps/bananas*.

- We use **any** in **questions** (**countable** nouns : crisps)
- We use **any** in **questions** (**uncountable** nouns : bread)
- With singular **countable** nouns we use **a** with words beginning with a **consonant** (a sandwich) and **an** with words beginning with a **vowel** (an apple)

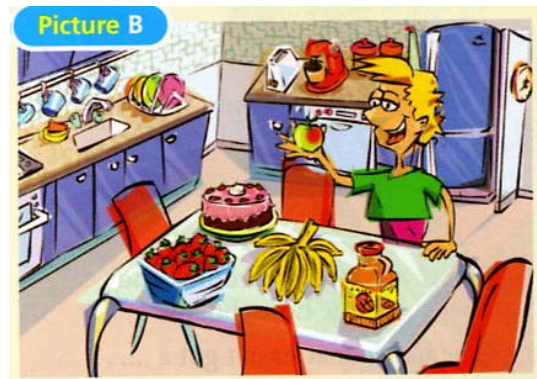

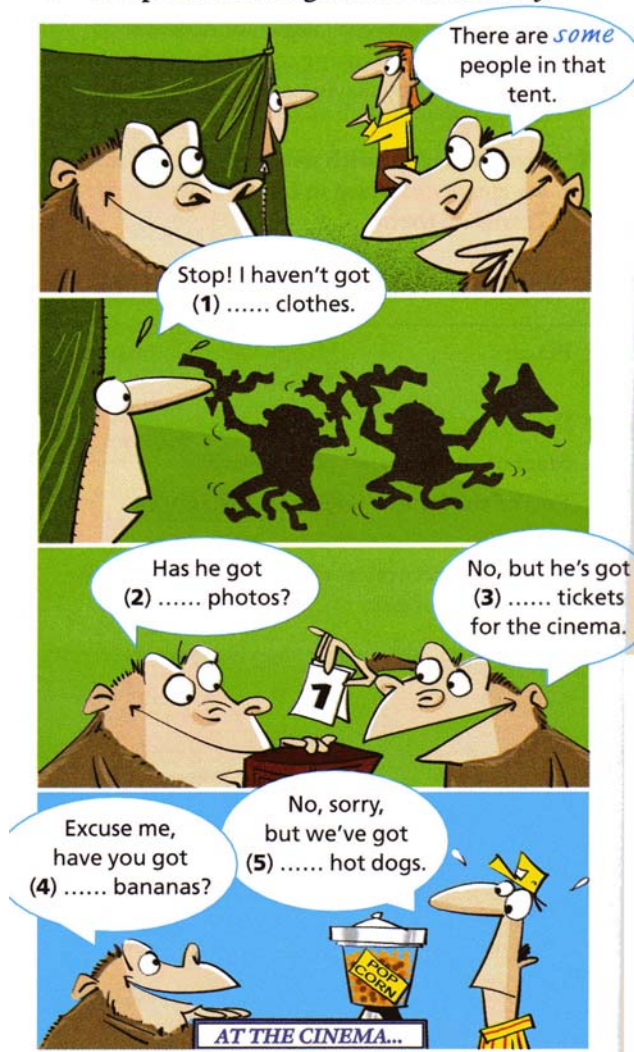
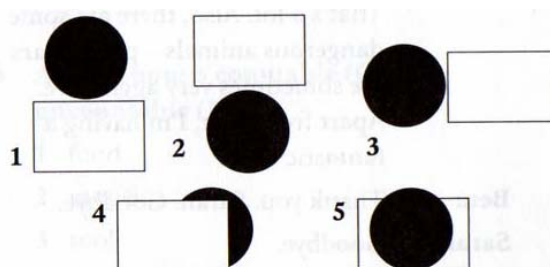
