Notice that you have to add words. You have to remember the key vocabulary that has been explained along this unit and use it properly. Here you have some tips...-

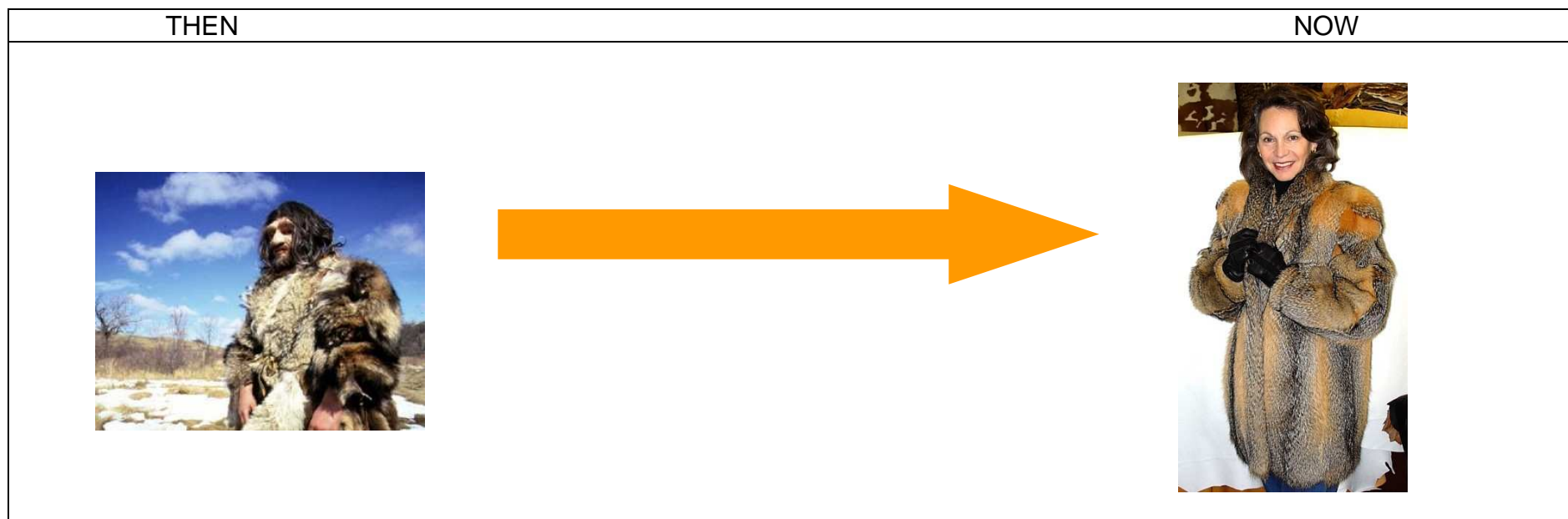
- to store food, water...
