

Teaching Notes

TOPIC: The Five Senses	Session: 3
GROUPING: 13 pupils	MATERIALS: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Powerpoint "Senses" - Set of cards: "Objects and senses" - Worksheet "Find the differences"
TIMING: 1 hour	
AIMS: - To understand that our senses help us to understand the world around us. - To identify the senses and the parts of the body involved.	

ACTIVITIES:

- Powerpoint "Senses": Review of the sensory organs, the actions that we can do with them and introducing the 5 senses. (20')
- Card game "Object and senses". Children will work in pairs. Each pair will have a set of 5 cards, each card will be the picture of an object. The 5 cards will be faced down and the kid will take one in his/her go and will have to say the sensory organ that may be involved. (20')
 - o If a kid takes the card of music, he/she will have to to say "hearing"
- Find the differences. The students will have to find the differences in two pictures. Afterwards they will compare the solutions with their classmates. This activity will be helpful to start talking about the sense of "sight" that will be introduced in the next session. (15')
- "Which sense did we use to find the differences?". Children will talk about the sense they used to find the differences and the sensory organ involved. (5')
