TOPIC: The Five Senses	Session: 5
GROUPING: 13 pupils	MATERIALS:
TIMING: 1 hour	 Powerpoint "Sight" Powerpoint "Hearing" Realia: hair dryer, alarm clock, coins, bell Band to cover the eyes

AIMS: - To understand that our senses help us to understand the world around us.

- To identify the senses and the parts of the body involved.
- To learn that the sense of hearing helps us to perceive noises and sounds.
- To respect oneself and others.

ACTIVITIES:

- Powerpoint "Sight": Review of the sense of sight. (10')
- Powerpoint "Hearing". Introducing the sense of hearing (15')
- Games (30')
 - "Discover the sound". The teacher will have a box with all the realia inside. There will a volunteer to have the eyes covered with the band, one volunteer for each of the four objects. The teacher will make a noise with the object and the child has to guess it, if he/she is right, everybody will say "Yes, right", if he/she is not right, everybody will say "No, wrong".(10')
 - "Chineese Whisper": All the students will be sitting down in a cercle. The teacher will whisper a word to one student, and he/she will have to pass it round. The last child will have to say the word aloud. (10')
 - "Who is talking?": The teacher will pick up a volunteer to have the eyes covered with the band. Then, the teacher will pick up a student to say a word aloud; the student with the eyes covered, will try to guess who the mate that talked is. (10')
- "Which sense did we use to play?". Children will talk about the sense they've used to play, the sensory organ, and the actions. (5')
