

Colour Qualities

White	It symbolises purity and liberation. It associates with water and often assigned to feminine planets such as The Moon and Venus.
Red	It associates with desire, fertility and manifestation. It relates to the masculine planets of Mars and the Sun.
Violet	It is associated with harmony. In its light shades it associates with tranquility and darker with passive
Orange	It is used to show the gentle masculine or feminine energies of the rising sun.
Yellow	It signifies the earth element and represents joy, abundance, general wealth and good fortune.
Pink	It has a calming and harmonising effect of the emotions. It can symbolise creativity manifesting and the potential for refined sensibility.
Green	It fosters communication and exchange and reflects similar properties, such as growth and fertility.
Blue	It is symbolically used for the air element. It relates to gentle and refined expression.
Black	It defines the light and all other colours. Through qualities of negativity and devolution it is also associated with the earth element.
Grey	In its smoky colour and associated with air and to the unseen and invisible energies.
