 Fritzlar is a small German town in the Schwalm- Eder district in northern Hesse


Fritzlar

The map of Fritzlar















- The town is dominated by the imposing Romanesque- Gothic cathedral from the 12th-14th centuries in the centre of the old town.

 He built a chapel from its wood at the site where today stands the cathedral of Fritzlar




The town hall, first documented in 1109, with a stone relief of St. Martin, the town's patron saint, is the oldest in Germany still in use for its original purpose.




