Teaching notes

Lesson 1: FLAT SHAPES

5 th session: Shapes at home	
AIMS	 To identify shapes in the surrounding environment. To classify objects according to their shapes. To work in groups.
RESOURCES	 A computer and a data projector for the power point presentation. 2-D geometrical shapes, e.g. Pattern Blocks Pieces or similar Everyday items such as newspapers, magazines, catalogues, pictures Supplementary material: (card_shapes.pdf) (flat_shapes_home.ppt).
GROUPING	-Half of the class. - Paired group.
DESCRIPTION OF THE ACTIVITIES	1 st activity: Game 'I spy with my little eye' (flat_shapes_home.ppt). Teacher holds up a shape and asks pupils to look for things the same shape in the classroom. "I spy with my little eye a shape like this". After looking for a few shapes, watch the power point presentation and find the shapes that are shown. 2 nd activity: Let's make a display! Look for things in magazines, newspapers, catalogues, pictures etc that are standard flat shapes. Classify them according to their shape in a big display. Ask pupils to look for more pictures at home and add them

	to the display according to the classification.
LANGUAGE	 Key vocabulary: Circle, triangle, square, rectangle, pentagon and hexagon. Newspapers, magazines, catalogues, pictures. Scissors, glue and display paper. key phrases needed: I spy with my little eye a shape like this (the answers to this sentence by pupils will be in L1 and teacher will say the name in English). What shape is this? It's a
