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| AIM | - To recall the lyrics of the Counting Rhyme. <br> - To be able to perform in front of the class. <br> - To work on social skills. |

| DESCRIPTION OF THE ACTIVITIES | $1^{\text {st }}$ activity: The mini book of 'The Monkeys Counting Rhyme' (monkeys_book.doc) <br> Give a copy of the mini book to the pupils and ask them to colour it. Then, the teacher explains the counting rhyme as it if were a story with the 'mini book'. <br> Watch again the monkeys power point presentation to revisit the Counting Rhyme. <br> $2^{\text {nd }}$ activity: <br> Performance of the Monkeys Counting Rhyme. <br> (monkeys_counting_rhyme.ppt). <br> (monkey_mask.pdf) (subtraction_symbol.pdf) <br> Watch the monkeys power point presentation to revisit the Counting Rhyme. Then, perform the story. You need |


|  | 5 monkey masks, 2 telephones and some dressing up <br> costumes for the mummy and the doctor(e.g. an apron <br> and a stethoscope). The five monkeys are jumping on <br> the bed and are falling off one by one according to the <br> the song. Draw a rectangle on the floor to represent <br> the bed and choose 5 children to be the monkeys. Each <br> time a monkey falls off another child holds up the <br> symbol -1 and another child the flashcard showing the <br> number of monkeys that are now jumping on the bed. <br> Repeat the performance two or three times to give all <br> the students the possibility of participating. <br> You can also perform the counting rhyme with the <br> finger puppets of all the characters as a puppet <br> theatre (finger_puppets.pdf) |
