## Teaching notes

## Lesson 1: COUNTING FROM 1-10

4 <sup>th</sup> session: The Elephants' performance.	
AIMS	<ul> <li>To recall the lyrics of the Counting Rhyme.</li> <li>To be able to perform in front of the class.</li> <li>To work on social skills.</li> </ul>
RESOURCES	- 5 Elephant masks Supplementary material: (elephants_counting_rhyme.ppt) (flashcard_addition_symbol.pdf) (numbers_flashcards.pdf) (elephant_mask.pdf) (elephants_book.doc)
GROUPING	- Half of the group.
DESCRIPTION OF THE ACTIVITIES	1 <sup>st</sup> activity: The 'mini-book' of 'The Elephants Counting Rhyme' (elephants_book.doc) Give a copy of the mini book to the pupils and ask them to decorate it. Then, the teacher explains the counting rhyme as it if were a story with the 'mini-book'.
	2 <sup>nd</sup> activity: Performance of the Counting Rhyme. (elephants_counting_rhyme.ppt) (elephant_mask.pdf) (addition_symbol.pdf) Watch again the power point presentation to revisit the meaning and lyrics of the counting rhyme. Then, perform the counting rhyme. You need 5 elephant masks and 5 chairs that represent the spider web. The first elephant sits on the first chair and the others come one by one as the children and teacher

	sing the Counting Rhyme. Each time another elephant comes, one child has to show the symbol +1 and another the number of elephants that are playing on the spider web. Repeat the performance two or three times to give all the students the possibility of participating.
LANGUAGE	Key vocabulary: - Numerals 1-10, elephants. Key phrases needed: - All the phrases included in the Counting Rhyme Well done! Give a big clap to your classmates.
SKILLS	Listening and speaking. Acting skills.
