7 <sup>th</sup> session: The Monkeys Counting Rhyme		
AIMS	<ul> <li>To recite the numbers in order, counting forwards and back.</li> <li>To find one less than a number from 0 to 5.</li> <li>To order numbers, up to 10.</li> <li>To become familiar with an English counting rhyme.</li> <li>To understand the whole meaning of the counting rhyme.</li> </ul>	
RESOURCES	<ul> <li>A computer and a data projector for the power point presentation.</li> <li>A smart board.</li> <li>Supplementary material: (put_numbers_in_order_smartboard) (monkeys_counting_rhyme.ppt)</li> </ul>	
GROUPING	-Half of the class.	
DESCRIPTION OF THE ACTIVITIES	1 <sup>st</sup> activity: Put the numbers in the right order (put_numbers_in_order_smartboard). Do the smart board activity asking for volunteers to order the numbers. Then, count from 1-10 doing different actions such as: clapping hands, slapping legs, touching opposite knees, hopping, jogging, jumping  2 <sup>nd</sup> activity: The Monkeys Counting Rhyme (monkeys_counting_rhyme.ppt)  Slides 1- 8 present the main characters and the vocabulary included in the counting rhyme. Then, the students watch slides 9-30 to listen to and understand the meaning of the monkeys counting rhyme. Invite the children to repeat the sentences to help them	

	memorise the counting rhyme.
LANGUAGE	Key vocabulary: - Numerals 1-10, monkeys, bed, mummy, doctor. Key phrases needed: - All the phrases included in the Counting Rhyme.
SKILLS	Speaking and listening. Ordering of number and number recognition
