• Les preguntes sobre el subjecte d'una oració no segueixen les regles d'inversió típiques, és a dir, no necesiten auxiliar.

> <u>Who</u> told you that? <u>Harry</u> told me. Subjecte Subjecte

• El verb happen, per exemple, sempre es refereix al subjecte.

What happened?

• Compara:

PREGUNTA DE SUBJECTE: Who loves your mother? (excepció: no verb auxiliar: Wh + verb + Complement )

- preguntem pel subjecte, per la persona que fa l'acció d'estimar.

PREGUNTA D'OBJECTE: Who does your mother love? (pregunta normal: WH + verb auxiliar + subjecte + verb principal + complements)

- preguntem per l'objecte que rep l'acció d'estimar. El subjecte ja el sabem, és la mare.
